Last Time Out

The Huskies had a split on the road at Calgary last weekend as they closed out the regular season. Friday night they lost 75-60 to the Dinos, after leading 34-30 at the half. **Rejean Chabot** led the Huskies in scoring with 15 points in the first half, finishing the game with 21 points. **Andrew Spagrud** fouled out leaving the game with 17 points and six rebounds. Calgary used their depth on the boards hauling down 42 rebounds as compared to 35 for Saskatchewan but was also aided by 24 turnovers while Calgary had 17. **Ross Bekkering** tallied 17 points for Calgary and hauled down nine rebounds while **Sonny Khangura** added a dozen points and seven rebounds. **Josh Feist** had 18 points and eight assists.

Saturday the Huskies led 36-35 at the break, but played a strong second half to earn a 79-70 victory. Spagrud paced the Huskies with 19 points and 10 rebounds, while Chabot chipped in with 17 points and **Kyle Grant** added 15. Khangura led the Dinos with a dozen points, and **Cody Darrah** added 11.

Quickly On Saskatchewan

The Huskies (18-18, 13-9) finished in second place in the Central Division standings, two games behind first place Alberta. The Huskies are the defending Central Division Champions, and won the division's regular season title in 2004-05 and 2005-06.

So far they are 11-4 at home, 5-10 on the road, and 2-4 on neutral courts.

So far this season the Huskies are averaging 78.3 points per game overall. The Huskies are giving up 76.4 points per game defensively.

Senior forward **Andrew Spagrud** leads the team with 21.3 points and 9.9 rebounds per game overall. He is for the team lead in steals with 2.3 spg. Senior guard **Kyle Grant** is second on the team in scoring with 15.3 points a game. Grant also averages 3.4 boards a contest, and leads the team in assists (3.8) and is tied in steals (2.3). Sophomore **Rejean Chabot** is third on the team with 14.8 points per game. Fourth-year senior guard **Jordan Harbidge** is fourth on the team with 7.9 points a game, and second in assists (3.3).

Quickly on Calgary

The Dinos (17-19, 11-11) finished in third place in the Central Division, two games behind the Huskies. Last Saturday's loss to the Huskies snapped their season-best five game winning streak.

So far this season they are 8-6 at home, 6-10 away and 3-3 on neutral courts. They are averaging 80.4 ppg overall, and giving up 79.8 ppg.

Josh Feist leads the team in scoring with 15.5 ppg overall. He also led Canada West in assists with 7.1 apg, and ranked 14th in three-point field goal percentage (.410). **Cody Darrah** averages 12.0 ppg and 2.2 assists. He ranked 12th in CW in three-point field goal percentage (.424). **Ross Bekkering** is second on the team in scoring with 12.4 ppg. he also leads the team with 7.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore forward **Robbie Sihota** puts up 12.3 points per game, and also grabs 6.8 boards a contest.

The Series Part I - vs. Calgary

The Saskatchewan/Calgary matchup has developed into quite a rivalry over the past nine years since head coach **Greg Jockims** arrived in Saskatoon. The Huskies hold a slight 18-16 advantage in the series over that span.

The Huskies are currently on a one-game winning streak vs. the Dinos, and have won four of five meetings this season. The Huskies are 3-0 at home in the series this season.

Saskatchewan is 8-1 vs. Calgary at the Physical Activity Complex since it opened for the 2003-04 season.. Their lone loss came February 12, 2006, dropping an 81-71 decision in the final game of the 2005-06 regular season.

The Series Part II - Postseason vs. Calgary

Despite being in the same conference the past 35 years, and the same division for the past six, Calgary and Saskatchewan have only met on one previous occasion in the postseason.

The Dinos lead the all-time postseason series 2-0, defeating the Huskies two games to none in the 1992-93 Canada West Final.

Connections

There are several connections between the Huskies and the Dinos. **Clint Unsworth** is a sophomore forward for the Huskies, while his brother **Chris Unsworth** is a freshman forward for the Dinos. Their father, Art, is a former Huskie himself.

Senior Huskies **Kalem Edlund** and **Mark Lynch** both played at Mount Royal College in Calgary before transferring to the UofS this season. While at MRC they were teammates for one season (2004-05) with Dino guard **Jeremy Odland**. Lynch also played one season (2003-04) with Dino fifth-year senior point guard **Josh Feist** at MRC.

Huskies in the Postseason Under Jockims

The Huskies have made the playoffs in six of the nine seasons since head coach **Greg Jockims** took over the program, compiling a 7-12 record.

The Dogs have won two of six series, advancing to the Central Division Final in 2001-02 over Lethbridge and defeating Alberta in the 2005-06 Central Division Final.

Lucky Number 13?

The Huskies posted 13 wins in conference play for the third consecutive season. The 39 wins is the most in conference play over a three-year span in the program's 91-year history.

Spagrud leads CW in scoring & rebounding

Andrew Spagrud finished conference play leading Canada West in both scoring (23.5 ppg) and rebounding (10.6 rpg).

He becomes the first Huskie to lead the conference in scoring since **Dean Wiebe** did it in 1993-94 (27.1 ppg). It's the seventh time a Huskie has led the conference in scoring.

Spagrud becomes the seventh player in Canada West history to lead the conference in both scoring and rebounding in the same season. He is the fourth Huskie to accomplish the feat.

Chabot's Contributions

Sophomore guard **Rejean Chabot** finished eighth in the conference in scoring with 16.7 points per game. That's an 11.3 ppg increase over his conference average as a freshman, when he posted 5.4 ppg. During conference play he's shot .515 percent from the field, and .404 percent from beyond the arc.

Chabot is averaging 19.5 ppg over the last eight games, and scored a career-high 28 points at Montana State-Northern on December 30th.

Huskies vs. the Top Ten

Saskatchewan is 3-4 against ranked teams this season. The won at No. 9 Guelph, at No. 10 Alberta, and against No. 5 UBC. They have lost at No. 6 Brock, at No. 10 McMaster, at No. 10 Alberta and against No. 8 Victoria.

Saskatchewan has a 6-4 all-time record vs. ranked teams at the Physical Activity Complex. They have not been ranked in any of those eight games.

The Huskies are 7-2 all-time at the PAC when they are ranked in the top ten. The Huskies have never played at the PAC when they and their opponent have both been ranked.

Ganes' School Conference Scoring Mark Broken

Andrew Spagrud broke the school's all-time record for points scored in conference games with a layup last Friday night at Calgary. Forward Roger Ganes held that record since 1978.
