### Last Time Out

The Huskies had a split on the road at then-No. 10 Alberta last weekend. Friday night the Huskies dominated the boards and the Golden Bears as they won 90-71. **Andrew Spagrud** had game-highs of 20 points and 10 rebounds to lead the Dogs. **Kyle Grant** had 18, **Rejean Chabot** scored 17 while **Jordan Harbidge** had 11 points. The Huskies shot 11-20 from beyond the arc and outrebounded the Bears 32-19. **C.G. Morrison** led Alberta with 15 points.

Saturday night it was Morrison who had the hot hand offensively. He was 9-10 from the field, scoring 24 points to lead the Bears to an 83-70 victory. The Bears led 50-33 at the half, and the Huskies would cut the lead to five with just under 9:00 remaining, but could get no closer. **Scott Gordon** added 17 points for the Bears, who shot 59.6% from the field. Spagrud had 19 points and 14 boards (his 18th double-double), and Chabot had 15 points.

## Quickly On Saskatchewan

The Huskies (16-16, 11-7) enter this weekend's action looking to try and make up some ground on first place Alberta, who they trail by two games in the Central Division standings. Alberta will also be playing UBC and UVic this weekend. The Huskies are the defending Central Division Champions, and have won the division's regular season title the past two years. So far they are 10-3 at home, 4-9 on the road, and 2-4 on neutral courts.

So far this season the Huskies are averaging 79.2 points per game overall. The Huskies are giving up 76.6 points per game defensively.

Senior forward **Andrew Spagrud** leads the team with 21.2 points and 9.5 rebounds per game overall. He is second on the team in steals with 2.3 spg. Senior guard **Kyle Grant** is second on the team in scoring with 16.0 points a game. Grant also averages 3.5 boards a contest, and leads the team in assists (3.8) and steals (2.4). Sophomore **Rejean Chabot** is third on the team with 13.6 points per game. Fourth-year senior guard **Jordan Harbidge** is fourth on the team with 8.6 points a game, and second in assists (3.4).

## Quickly on Victoria

The Vikes (20-8, 16-3) are in second place in the Pacific Division, one game behind UBC. Last Friday they beat SFU 79-49, and on Saturday they needed a **Jacob Doerksen** buzzer-beater to win 68-65 over SFU.

So far this season they are 12-2 at home, 7-5 away and 0-2 on neutral courts. They are averaging 75.8 ppg overall, and giving up 68.9 ppg.

**Brandon Ellis** leads the team in scoring with 13.1 ppg overall. Doerksen is second on the team with 13.0 ppg. He also averages 4.9 rpg. **Josh Whyte** averages 12.7 ppg and 4.9 assists. he also leads the squad with 1.4 steals per game. **Graeme Bollinger** scores 10.6 ppg and grabs 7.7 rpg.

## Quickly on British Columbia

The Thunderbirds (23-9, 17-2) are in first place in the Pacific Division. They had their Canada West record 33-game conference winning streak broken at Brandon 87-77 January 12th. So far this season they are 11-4 at home, 10-3 away and 2-2 on neutral courts. There four home losses have all been to NCAA Division I schools. They are scoring 80.5 points per game, and giving up 73.9 ppg overall. Last week they beat TWU 101-79 and 85-77.

**Casey Archibald** is averaging 20.6 ppg overall. He also leads the team with 4.4 apg and 1.8 spg. **Chris Dyck** is averaging 14.3 ppg and leads the squad in three-point percentage (.472). **Matt Rachar** averages 6.4 boards per game.

## The Series Part I - vs. Victoria

Victoria has dominated the series with the Huskies. The Vikes strong teams of the 80's and 90's made the Vikes a national power, and at one point they won seven national titles in a row. UVic is on a four-game winning streak vs. the Huskies, having won all four meetings last season. The last meeting was before 6663 fans and seen on national television (The Score) from Halifax in the National Championship Quarter-Final last March 17th. Victoria defeated the Dogs 79-64, and ended up losing the National Final to Carleton 73-67.

In that game the Huskies shot 45.5% from the field for the game (including only 37.0% in the second half), not bad considering they were 0-13 from beyond the arc. The Vikes shot 54.7% from the floor, and were 3-10 from downtown. The Vikes led 42-32 at halftime.

**Brandon Ellis** led the Vikes with 24 points, and was 8-10 from the free throw line. **Chris Trumpy** added 13 points and nine assists, while **Jacob Doerksen** had 14 points and six rebounds off the bench.

**Andrew Spagrud** had 22 points, four boards and four steals for the Huskies. **Kyle Grant** had 14 points and five assists, while Matt Greenberg added 11 points. **Jordan Harbidge** had nine points off the bench.

## The Series Part II - vs. UBC

UBC leads the all-time series 110-42 since the first meeting between the schools in 1931-32. Since 1977, UBC holds a 64-35 advantage. During that time period, Saskatchewan is 21-24 at home, 11-37 on the road and 3-3 on neutral courts.

Saskatchewan is 4-9 against UBC the past nine years since head coach **Greg Jockims** arrived in Saskatoon. UBC won the last meeting 73-72 at Vancouver March 3, 2006 in the Canada West Final Four Semi-Final.

**Chad Clifford** came up with a game-clinching block in the dying seconds to preserve a precarious one-point edge as the top-seeded UBC men's basketball team pulled out a 73-72 victory over the fourth-seeded Saskatchewan Huskies.

Clifford's block came on the tail end of a quick series of events that began with Saskatchewan point guard **Rob Lovelace** picking off an errant cross-court pass from **Casey Archibald** with just eight seconds left. With a swarm of UBC defenders gathering around him, Lovelace leapt towards the basket only to have Clifford thwart his winning attempt, blocking him from behind and controlling the loose ball.

Saskatchewan star **Andrew Spagrud** converted on a pivotal hoop-and-harm play in the paint that closed the gap to a single point with 35.2 seconds left and set the stage for the definitive final sequence.

UBC shot a dismal 9-for-22 from the free throw line on the night, including an abysmal 3-of-14 in the second half.

Archibald, the 2005-06 Canada West player of the year, paced the host side with 19 points, six assists and five rebounds, while first team all-conference player **Pasha Bains** also had a strong all-around performance with 17 points, eight rebounds and six assists.

Spagrud led all players with a monster 28-point, 10-rebound effort, hitting 10-of-20 field goal attempts and 8-of-

13 tries from the line. **Kyle Grant** added 13 points, **Sam Lamontagne** chipped in 12 and **Kevin Langdon** had 10. Grant and Lovelace played a very good defensive game, helping to hold UBC stars Archibald and Bains in check.

The Huskies won the last meeting that was in Saskatoon 102-87 on January 21, 2005. **Matt Greenberg** scored a career-high 25 points, including 15 in the first half as the Huskies opened up a 55-37 lead at the half. Saskatchewan shot a blistering 71.0% from the floor in the first half, while UBC was a very respectable 51.5%.

The Huskies pushed their lead to 26 less than four minutes into the second half. Up 75-56 after a steal and jumper by **Jordan Harbidge** with 12:28 to play, UBC started to make a comeback. A layup by **Casey Archibald** cut the Huskie lead to 79-71 with 8:18 remaining. The Dogs quickly pushed the lead back to 16, before hitting some free throws down the stretch to seal the 15 point victory.

Greenberg was 8-11 from the field, including 2-3 from three-point range. He was also 7-8 from the free throw line. **Andrew Spagrud** added 20 points and five assists. **Rob Lovelace** had 19 points, while **Sam Lamontagne** and **Kyle Grant** added 11 points each. Grant also had four steals.

Archibald led the Thunderbirds with a game-high 28 points. Archibald, who played all 40 minutes, did turn the ball over 10 times though. **Ryder McKeown** was a force inside for UBC, going 9-10 from the floor, scoring 20 points and grabbing eight rebounds.

## Huskies vs. the Top Ten

Saskatchewan is 2-3 against ranked teams this season. The won at No. 9 Guelph and at No. 10 Alberta, and have lost at No. 6 Brock, at No. 10 McMaster and at No. 10 Alberta.

Saskatchewan has a 5-3 all-time record vs. ranked teams at the Physical Activity Complex. They have not been ranked in any of those eight games.

The Huskies are 7-2 all-time at the PAC when they are ranked in the top ten. The Huskies have never played at the PAC when they and their opponent have both been ranked.
