Last Time Out

Last Friday night at the Physical Activity Complex Saskatchewan defeated Lethbridge 96-83 as **Andrew Spagrud** exploded for 41 points, tying his career-high. He was 15-18 from the floor, and also grabbed 11 rebounds.

Kyle Grant had 17 points and four steals, while **Rejean Chabot** added 13 points and three assists. **Jordan Harbidge** had 10 points and four assists.

Saturday night the Pronghorns pulled away in the final minute of play to earn a 78-70 victory over the Huskies. Freshman **Tim McMurray** hit a three-pointer with 1:31 remaining in the game to put Lethbridge up 71-66. From there Lethbridge hit seven of eight free throws to secure the victory.

Chabot scored a game-high 17 points to lead the Huskies. Spagrud scored 13 points and grabbed a game-high nine rebounds. **Scott Mackinnon** paced the Pronghorns with 16 points and six rebounds.

Quickly On Saskatchewan

The Huskies (12-14, 7-5) enter this weekend's action looking to keep pace with first place Alberta, who they trail by one game in the Central Division standings. The Huskies are the defending Central Division Champions, and have won the division's regular season title the past two years. So far they are 8-3 at home, 2-7 on the road, and 2-4 on neutral courts.

Last weekend Saskatchewan split their two games with Lethbridge, ending the season series between the two schools tied 2-2.

So far this season the Huskies are averaging 77.8 points per game. The Huskies are giving up 75.8 points per game defensively.

Senior forward **Andrew Spagrud** leads the team with 21.0 points and 9.4 rebounds per game overall. He also leads the team in steals with 2.6 spg. Senior guard **Kyle Grant** is second on the team in scoring with 16.0 points a game. Grant also averages 3.6 boards a contest, and leads the team in assists (3.7) and is second in steals (2.3). Sophomore **Rejean Chabot** is third on the team with 12.8 points per game. Fourth-year senior guard **Jordan Harbidge** is fourth on the team with 8.3 points a game, and second in assists (3.3).

Quickly on Manitoba

The Bisons (11-12, 4-8) are sitting in fourth place in the Great Plains Division, one game behind second place Winnipeg. Last Friday on their home floor they beat Winnipeg 75-74 on an **Isaac Ansh** free throw in the dying seconds. Saturday night at Winnipeg they lost 75-56.

So far this season they are 6-6 at home, 1-5 away and 4-1 on neutral courts. They are averaging 71.0 points per game, and giving up 72.1 ppg.

Ansh is fifth in the conference in scoring with 21.3 ppg. He also ranks 8th with 4.3 assists per game. **Darcy Coss** is 14th in scoring 14.3 ppg.

Quickly on Winnipeg

The Wesmen (12-9, 5-7) are tied with Regina for second place in the Great Plains Division, five games behind first place No. 8 Brandon.

So far this season they are 6-4 at home, 2-4 away and 4-1 on neutral courts. They are scoring 74.0 points per game, and giving up 70.5 ppg overall.

Erfan Nasajpour is second in the country in scoring at 23.3 ppg. He leads the conference in assists with 6.5 per game. **Dan Shynkaryk** is second on the team in scoring at 14.3 ppg. **Ivan Saric** is fourth in CW with 8.0 ppg.

The Huskies have three captains this season. Fourth-year seniors **Kyle Grant**, **Jordan Harbidge** and **Andrew Spagrud** were appointed team captains this year.

Grant Reaches Career Milestone

Kyle Grant reached a career milestone during Saskatchewan's 105-53 victory over Lakeland September 30th..

Grant, a fourth-year senior guard from Moose Jaw, became the 31st Huskie in the program's history to score 1000 career points. He reached the milestone on a layup after a steal early in the second half. Grant finished the game with a career-high 31 points, bringing his career total to 1011.

Grant becomes the third member of the 1000-point club on this year's Huskie squad. **Andrew Spagrud** and **Sam Lamontagne** are the other members of the 1000-point club.

Harbidge Hits Century Mark

Jordan Harbidge hit the 100th three-pointer of his career Saturday afternoon against Montana State-Northern. That puts him in 11th place on the all-time list for three-point field goals made.

Sam Lamontagne currently sits second on the all-time list (174), while **Kyle Grant** is tied for fifth (146). **Darrin Rask** is the Huskies all-time leader (260).
