### Last Time Out

Last Friday night at the Physical Activity Complex Saskatchewan set a school record hitting 16 three-pointers as they defeated Manitoba 98-73. The Huskies were 16-23 from beyond the arc, as seven players hit at least two three's each. **Jordan Harbidge** was 5-5 from downtown, scoring a career-high 20 points. **Andrew Spagrud** had 26 points in 22 minutes, while **Rejean Chabot** added 11 points. **David Neufeld** scored 10 points off the bench.

Saturday night Saskatchewan beat Winnipeg 86-76 in what was an intense, physical and heated game. Five players fouled out and **Erfan Nasajpour** was ejected for Winnipeg, as seven technical fouls were also handed out in the game. Spagrud had game-highs of 28 points and 14 rebounds. **Kyle Grant** tied the school record by hitting 18 of his 20 free throw attempts. Chabot, who received eight stitches after the game above his left eye and under his chin, finished with 16 points and four boards.

## Quickly On Saskatchewan

The Huskies (14-14, 9-5) enter this weekend's action looking to keep pace with first place Alberta, who they trail by one game in the Central Division standings. Alberta will also be playing at SFU and TWU this weekend. The Huskies are the defending Central Division Champions, and have won the division's regular season title the past two years. So far they are 10-3 at home, 2-7 on the road, and 2-4 on neutral courts.

Last weekend they beat Manitoba 98-73 and Winnipeg 86-76.

So far this season the Huskies are averaging 78.8 points per game. The Huskies are giving up 75.8 points per game defensively.

Senior forward **Andrew Spagrud** leads the team with 21.4 points and 9.4 rebounds per game overall. He also leads the team in steals with 2.5 spg. Senior guard **Kyle Grant** is second on the team in scoring with 15.9 points a game. Grant also averages 3.5 boards a contest, and leads the team in assists (3.8) and is tied for the lead in steals (2.5). Sophomore **Rejean Chabot** is third on the team with 12.8 points per game. Fourth-year senior guard **Jordan Harbidge** is fourth on the team with 8.6 points a game, and second in assists (3.3).

## Quickly on Trinity Western

The Spartans (11-12, 8-8) are tied for third place in the Pacific Division with SFU, three games up on fifth place Fraser Valley. Last Thursday they lost 87-80 at UCFV, and on Saturday they won 95-92 at TRU.

So far this season they are 6-2 at home, 3-6 away and 2-4 on neutral courts. They are averaging 84.8 points per game, and giving up 88.7 ppg.

**Brian Banman** is fifth in the conference in scoring with 20.3 ppg. He also averages 3.7 rpg and 2.2 apg. **Luke Robinson** is 28th in scoring at 12.6 ppg. **Jon Schmidt** scores 11.1 ppg and dishes out 4.9 apg. **David Bron** averages 4.0 rpg

## Quickly on Simon Fraser

The Clan (15-11, 8-8) are tied with TWU for third place in the Pacific Division. So far this season they are 7-6 at home, 5-5 away and 3-0 on neutral courts. They are scoring 71.2 points per game, and giving up 70.8 ppg overall. Last week they won 78-68 at TRU, and lost 61-56 in OT at UCFV.

**Aaron Christensen** is sixth in the conference in scoring at 20.1 ppg. He's fourth in rebounds with 7.8 per game. **Greg Wallis** is second on the team in scoring at 11.8 ppg. **Kevin Shaw** is 6th in CW in 3FG% at .515 (34-66).

## Record Night At The Free Throw Line

The Huskies attempted a school record 59 free throws Saturday night against Winnipeg. The previous record was 53. **Kyle Grant** hit 18 of his 20 attempts, tying the school record for made free throws in a game. Ten of his attempts came off of technical fouls.

## Close Only Counts in Horseshoes And Hand Grenades

The Huskies have lost five conference games this season. In four of those games the Huskies have been tied or leading with under two minutes to play. In the other game Lethbridge was up three with 3:35 to go when they pulled away at home.

## Grant Reaches Career Milestone

**Kyle Grant** reached a career milestone during Saskatchewan's 105-53 victory over Lakeland September 30th..

Grant, a fourth-year senior guard from Moose Jaw, became the 31st Huskie in the program's history to score 1000 career points. He reached the milestone on a layup after a steal early in the second half. Grant finished the game with a career-high 31 points, bringing his career total to 1011.

Grant becomes the third member of the 1000-point club on this year's Huskie squad. **Andrew Spagrud** and **Sam Lamontagne** are the other members of the 1000-point club.
